

GEN55 Obtain and monitor the use of the funds required to implement plans to meet local needs for health care services

OVERVIEW

This standard is about contributing to the development and review of the local health care strategy by obtaining and monitoring the use of the funds required to implement plans to meet local needs for health care services. There are many statutory agencies - as well as referrers, providers etc - involved in the commissioning of health care services. It is important that all partners support the overall local strategy and are clear about their individual roles and responsibilities for commissioning specific services. Users of this standard will need to ensure that practice reflects up to date information and policies. Version No 1

- 6.where the required funds are not available in full, agree with partner agencies how your plans should be adjusted in line with national policies and local priorities
- 7.monitor the use of funds in line with budgets, and take appropriate corrective action in the light of significant variances
