

# **GEN56** Review strategies and plans to meet local needs for health care services

### **OVERVIEW**

This standard is about contributing to the development and review of the local health care strategy by reviewing strategies and plans for commissioning health care services. There are many statutory agencies - as well as referrers, providers etc - involved in the commissioning of health care services. It is important that all partners support the overall local strategy and are clear about their individual roles and responsibilities for commissioning specific services. Users of this standard will need to ensure that practice reflects up to date information and policies.Version No 1

- 9.Your own role and the limits of your responsibility and authority

- 6.agree with partner agencies the contribution that you and your agency should make to the review and evaluation of the local health care strategy
- 7.make appropriate contributions to reviewing and evaluating the local health care strategy
- 8.ensure your contributions are designed to enhance and improve the local health care strategy
- 9.involve key stakeholders appropriately in the review and evaluation of the local health care strategy
